

Laugh Lines - Giggles Galore at Comedy Night

This year's Strawberry Festival will feature a great lineup of Canadian talent at Giggles Comedy Night, which takes place under the festival marquee at 9 p.m. June 29.

Matthew DiSero's Comedy Magic uses interaction as a key element of his performance. The comedian invites audience members onstage to assist with the magic, making them the stars of the show in the process. A highly popular corporate performer, DiSero has taken his show on tour with the Canadian Armed Forces to Cyprus, Bosnia, the United Arab Emirates and the North Pole, and has performed on television and radio in Canada and the U.S.

Perry Perlmutar's material covers a wide range of topics, from his experience as a Jewish man married to a Muslim women, to his former job as an ESL teacher. With his unique perspective and amiable personality, he has built an enthusiastic following in the comedy clubs around Toronto. Television appearances include Much Music's Video on Trial and his own Comedy Now! special on CTV and the Comedy Network.

Dylan Mandlsohn, with his rubber face and cast of charismatic stand-up characters, is the first Canadian to be a back-to-back finalist at the prestigious San Francisco and Seattle Comedy competitions. After impressive performances at Montréal's Just For Laughs and The Boston Comedy Festival, Dylan was selected for The Comcast Network, which paved the way for new and exciting roles in television and film.

Inspired by Jim Carrey, Johnny Carson and Rich Little, Mandlsohn is a master impressionist who uses comedy to challenge the status quo and push the boundaries of conventional wisdom.
