

Starlight Cinema Set To Shine This Fall

Film Circuit series at Nineteen on the Park

This fall, the Lebovic Centre for Arts and Entertainment – Nineteen on the Park will host its first Film Circuit series, beginning Sept. 9.

Film Circuit, a division of the Toronto International Film Festival Group (TIFFG), provides Canadian and international independent films for screening in communities with limited access to movie theatres. The organization serves more than 200 groups in 164 communities across Canada and is essential in helping TIFFG lead the world in building markets and audiences for Canadian cinema.

Groups in each community work with Film Circuit staff to organize screenings, allowing film fans to enjoy movies that they would have little opportunity to see

elsewhere. Most of the movies selected are shown only on a limited release basis at independent theatres in downtown Toronto. For more information on the program visit www.filmcircuit.ca.

Items of interest bought for Vandorf Hall by Vandorf Women's Institute

Dec. 1925: Oak piano \$318.25

Many donations to equip hall kitchen

Nov. 1935: bought new stove for kitchen

1930: installed hydro in hall

Apr. 1953: paid \$10 for a tree at the hall

June 1956: proceeds from play put in fund for washrooms at hall

Feb. 1957: bought coffee urn for hall

Oct. 1959: donated dishes to hall and decided to purchase silver and glassware when suitable storage was arranged. Mrs.

A. van Nostrand, Mrs. Powell and Mrs. Starr were asked to act on the kitchen-designing committee

July 1960: \$221.52 donated – bought cart, trays, roll baskets and coffee makers

Sep. 1966: bought electric kettle

June 1973: \$24.82 for dishes

Sep. 1977: bought insulated coffee urn

We are still donating tea towels and silverware

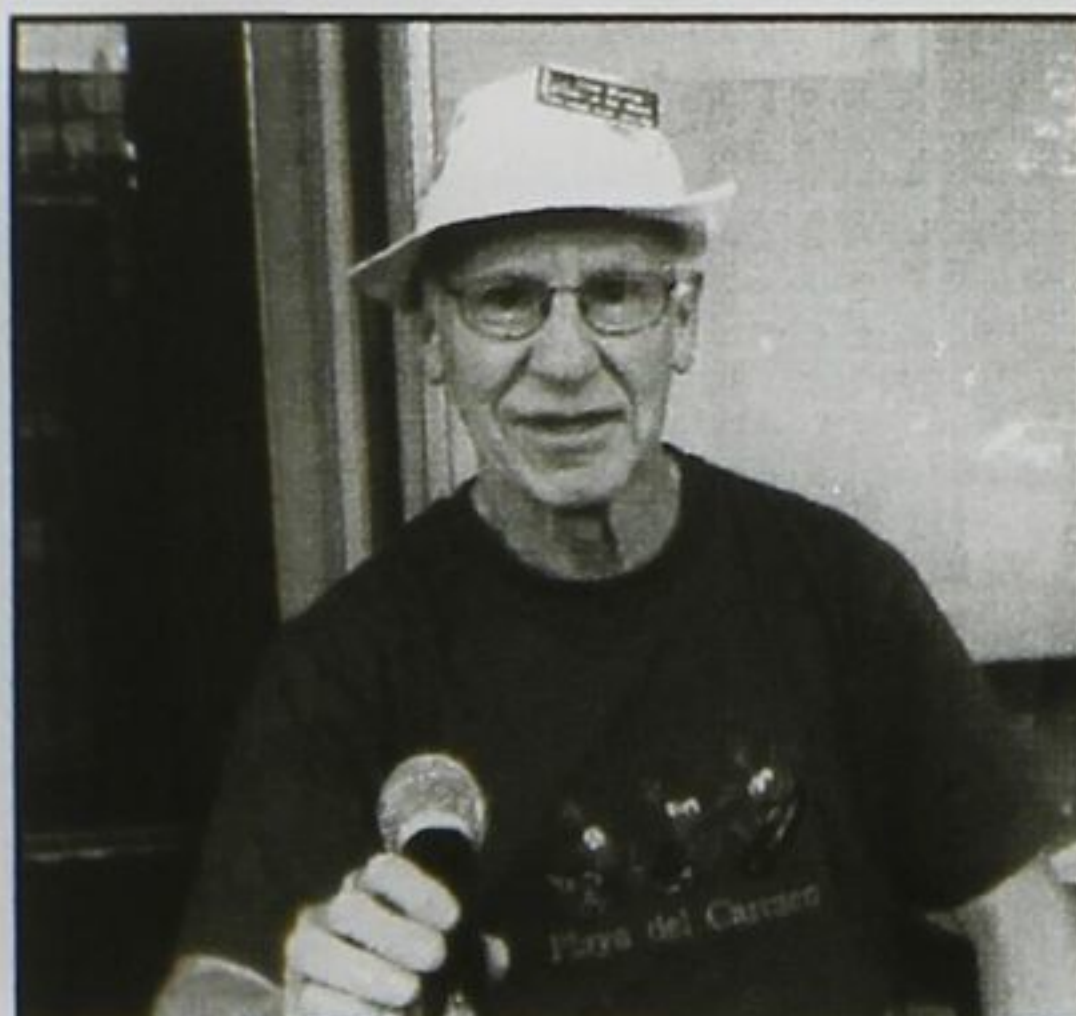

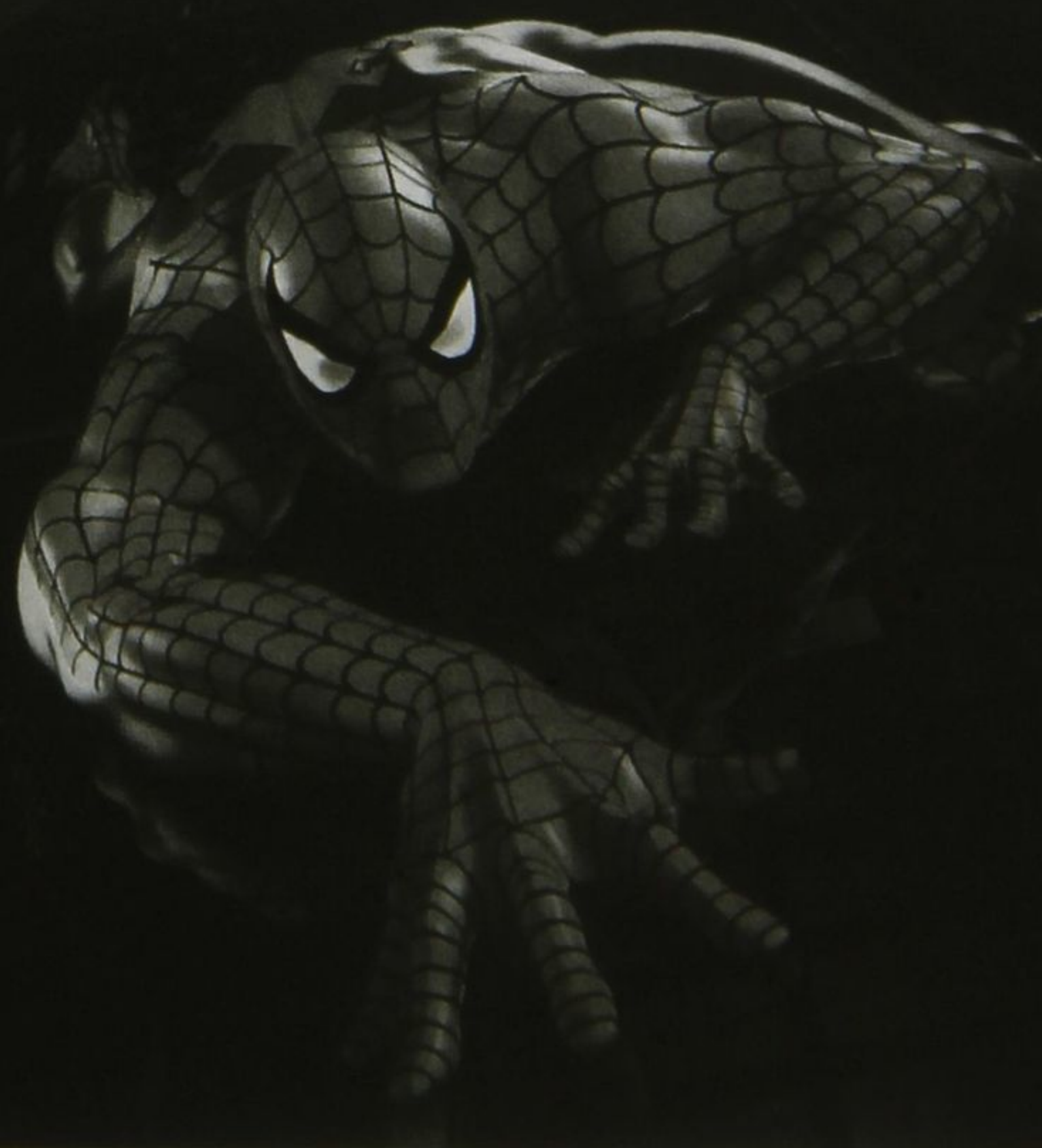
