
staff, Hope's legs have been straightened and she is able to walk unaided. The Michael 'Pinball' Clemons Foundation, which was launched on Sept. 19 at the gala fundraiser attended by Dr. Ekure, is working in partnership with CBMI to build an operating room for the hospital.

Dr. Ekure's speech at the gala, in which he described Hope's progress, was greeted with a standing ovation. His gentleness and humility have won him friends wherever he goes and when praised for his dedication, his response is to thank other people. "I'm very, very grateful for the support of Canadians. They are taking part in the fight against poverty, disease and fear."

While he could reap considerable financial benefits in private practice, he prefers to devote himself to those who need him most. "When I see the many children lined up for clinic waiting patiently for hours, and the expectant look in the eyes of their mothers, I know the need is too great to think only of myself, and I am reminded that when I needed help, people (Canadians) I did not even know were there for me."


