Kitchen Safety:

 - If someone gets burned run or soak the wound for 5 minutes to ease the pain.

Electrical Safety:

- If appliances smoke or smell of burning unplug and replace.
- Check all extension cords and replace if frayed or if they have exposed wiring.

As fire departments across North America suit up for Fire Prevention Week October 4-9, Whitchurch-Stouffville Fire & Emergency is advising everyone to bone up on their preparedness. "Your family can survive even a major fire in your home if you have working smoke alarms to alert you of a fire and have practised a home escape plan to get out quickly," noted Fire Prevention Officer Jeff Bignell. Bignell cautioned that in the province of Ontario, the majority of fatal fires occur during the night when people are asleep. "It is extremely important to ensure your home has working smoke alarms on every level of the home and outside all sleeping areas," he said. "Smoke alarms should be checked once a month and batteries should be changed at least once a year when clocks are reset. It is important that all persons living in the home are familiar with the sound of the smoke alarms. Once you are alerted to a fire, you may have no time to plan your escape. This is why you should take the time to make a home fire escape plan."

- 1) Draw a floor plan of your home. Show two ways out of every room.
- 2) Determine a safe meeting place outside of the home.
- 3) Ensure 9-1-1 is called from a safe location.
- 4) Practise your plan with the whole family to ensure everyone is familiar with the plan.

"Get out quickly and safely. Do not gather possessions, no possessions are worth your life. Once you have escaped from the burning building, do not go back inside for any reason."
