She performed at three concerts in Johannesburg in June as part of World Cup of Soccer celebrations. Her song Sueños Posibles (Dreams Realized) was written in honour of the first World Cup game between Mexico and South Africa. Amanda's mother is from South Africa and her father is Mexican.

phone with a VISA card. A tax receipt for \$35 will be issued for each ticket. Only 150 tickets will be sold.




