

Amanda Martinez To Headline Latcham Gala

Award-winning Latin jazz singer Amanda Martinez will perform at a Latcham Gallery fundraising gala Oct. 23 at the Lebovic Centre for Arts and Entertainment.

Martinez brings flair and variety to her repertoire. Her sound is a blend of musical influences, including flamenco inspired rhythms, Afro-Cuban beats and Mexican folk music. She has sold out Toronto's 1,100 seat Koerner Hall at the Royal Conservatory, and performed to a full house at New York's Bluenote Jazz Club. Two thousand and ten has been an exciting year for the singer, with a sold out performance alongside Jesse Cook at Massey Hall.

For each of the past three years she has been nominated for Latin Jazz Artist of the Year at Canada's National Jazz Awards, and her debut album *Sola* won for Best World Music album. She performed at three concerts in Johannesburg in June as part of World Cup of Soccer celebrations. Her song *Sueños Posibles* (Dreams Realized) was written in honour of the first World Cup game between Mexico and South Africa. Amanda's mother is from South Africa and her father is Mexican.

An art auction and silent auction will accompany the Oct. 23 concert to raise much-needed funds for the gallery. Tickets for the gala are \$75 each and are available from the Latcham Gallery at 6240 Main Street. They can also be purchased by phone with a VISA card. A tax receipt for \$35 will be issued for each ticket. Only 150 tickets will be sold.

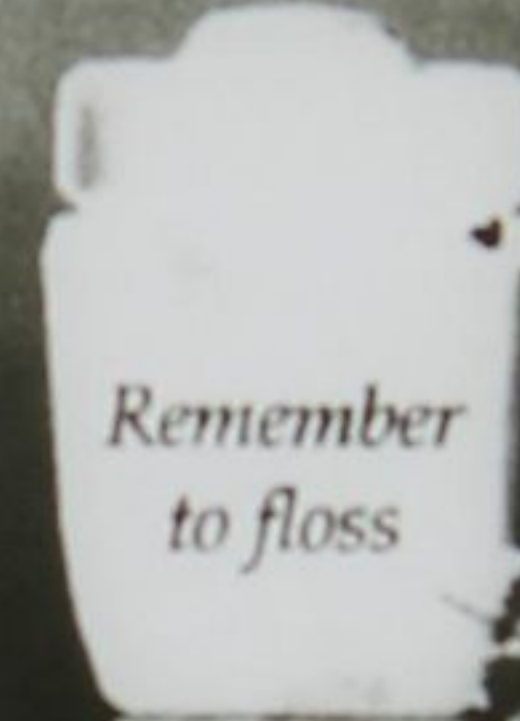
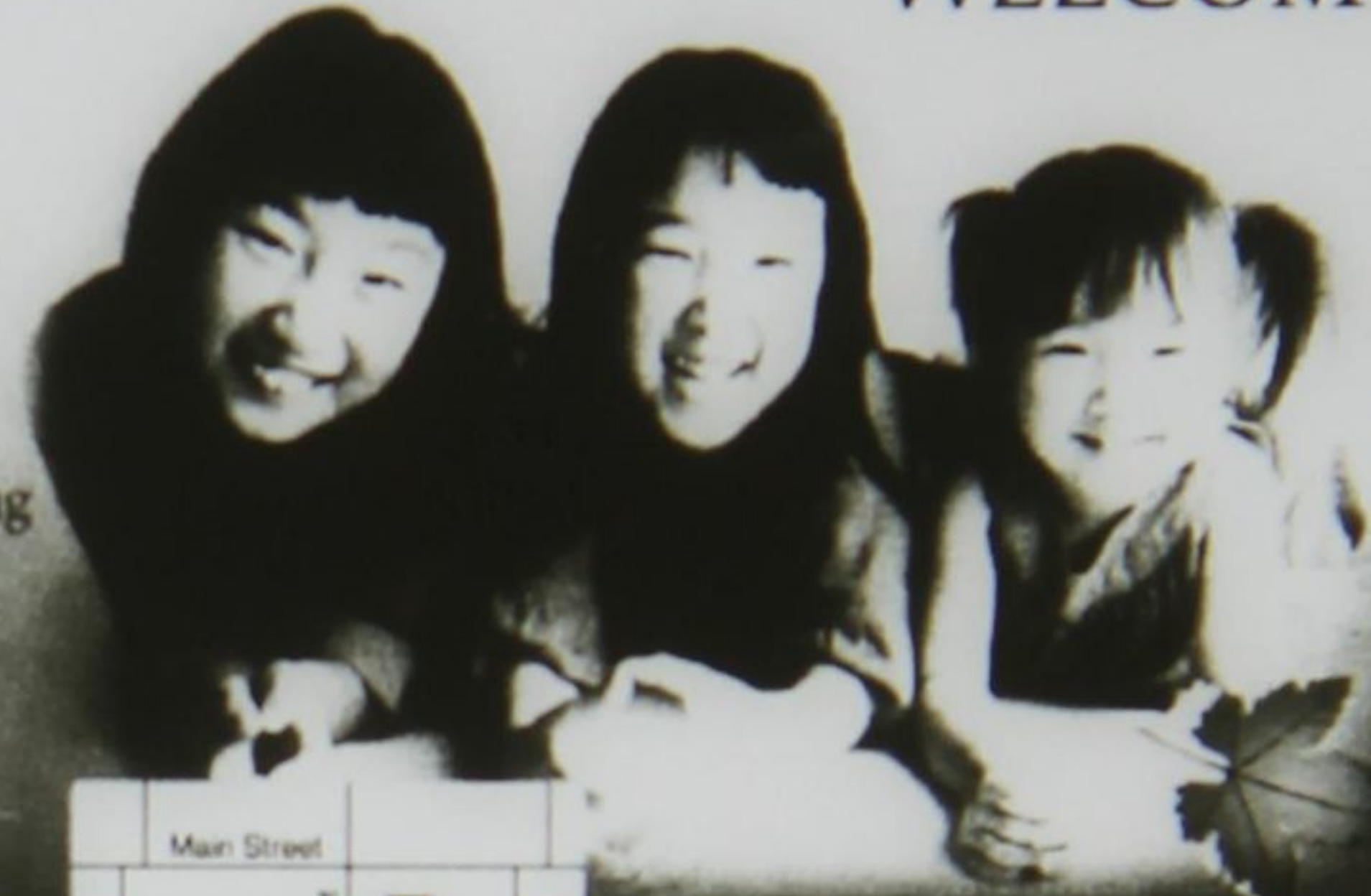

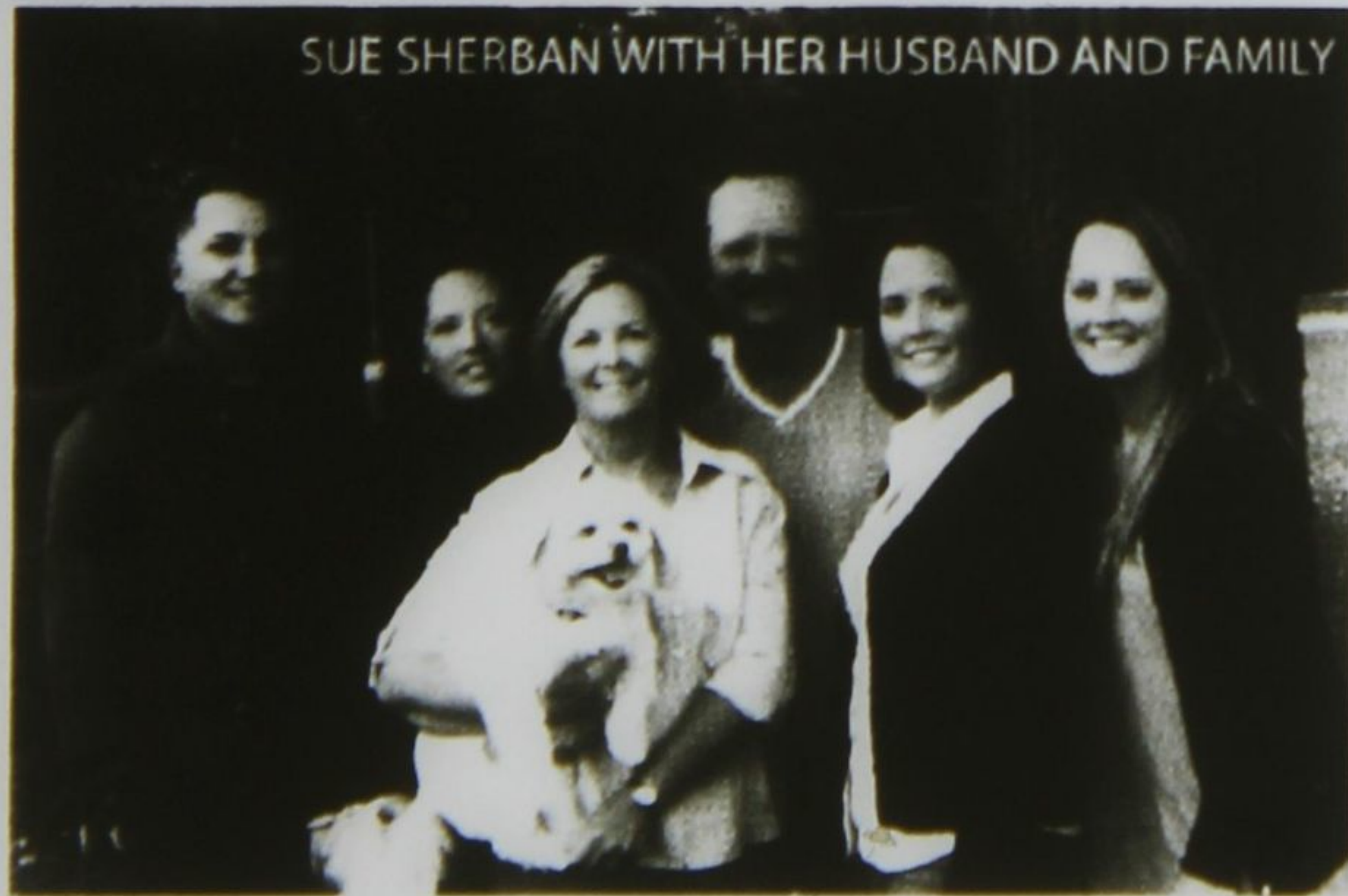
