## REMEMBRANCE DAY AT STARLIGHT CINEMA

On Nov. 11 at 7 p.m., Starlight Cinema at the Lebovic Centre for Arts and Entertainment - Nineteen on the Park will host a screening of the acclaimed Paul Gross movie Passchendaele.

Set at the height of World War I, the film tells the story of Sergeant Dunne, who is sent home after being wounded on the battlefield. While recovering in the military hospital in Calgary, he falls in love with a mysterious nurse. As their lives become intertwined, they are each haunted by the past, while a nation's future hangs in the balance. Culminating in the Battle of Passchendaele in 1917, the film transcends the particularities of war and embraces the enduring affairs of mind, heart and country.


"As a proud Canadian, it has long been my ambition to bring this powerful period in our nation's history to the world," writes Mr. Gross. "It started many years ago, listening to stories my grandfather told of his involvement in the conflict. He was a proud man and a proud member of the Canadian Expeditionary Force. The war was the formative event in his life and he believed that our understanding of what it means to be Canadian was forged in the crucible of the Western Front."

Passchendaele is the second in a series of movies screened as part of Toronto International Film Festival's Film Circuit. Movies will be shown at 7 p.m. on the second Wednesday of each month until June, and season passes are available now from the box office. Passes for the remaining eight films in

the series are \$45.

Single tickets are \$7.50 will also be offered on the night of the screening, space permitting. The December 9 movie is The Brothers Bloom, starring Adrien Brody and Rachel Weisz. The series is sponsored by the Stouffville Free Press.
