



A Gasoline Waterworks Plant.

The above cut is of a waterworks pumping plant run by a Gasoline Engine and located at Oswego, Illinois. It consists of a Triplex power pump running belt...

The time needed to keep up the supply would not be more than two or three hours per day at the outside and the pump could have sufficient capacity to supply us during a good fire.

With a steam plant a skilled man is required. A gasoline plant can be operated safely by an attendant not previously skilled in the management of gasoline engines.
