car show are Kruzin' Kuizine and Belfiore Foods along with Mister Softee ice cream.

On average, 300 antique and classic cars take over the museum's property.

Admission is \$5 for people aged three and up or \$15 for a family of four.

All money raised will go towards the creation of a permanent Whitchurch-Stouffville exhibit, which is expected to open this November.

The museum is located at 14732 Woodbine Ave.
