BMW going 105 km/h over limit: police

A Richmond Hill man was charged with stunt driving in the Preston Lake area of Whitchurch-Stouffville during the long weekend.

Officers clocked a BMW Z3 at 165 km/h in a posted 60 km/h zone on Bloomington Road between Woodbine and Warden avenues, according to York Regional Police. To go along with the charge, a 27-year-old man had his sports car impounded for seven days.

He was one of two drivers charged with stunt driving over the long weekend in York Region. Seventeen other drivers were charged with impaired and dangerous driving, according to police.

Excessive speed has consistently been the greatest contributing factor in many fatal col-

lisions on York roads, according to police.


When contacting police to report speeders, try to note the vehicle's location, direction of travel, make, model, licence plate number and driver description.


