WATER bills have now been mailed. If you do not receive your bill please contact our Customer Service Centre. Failure to receive a water bill does not eliminate the responsibility for payment of water or the penalty charge for late payment.

WATER PAYMENTS may be made by mail, at most Financial Institutions, banking machines, by telephone and internet or in person at the Municipal Offices. After hours, water payments may be made in the drop box at the main entrance of the Municipal Offices. For inquiries, please contact Customer Service.

The Town will no longer accept credit cards for payment of your water accounts.

HELPFUL REMINDERS FOR RECYCLING ON WINDY DAYS

Unfortunately it always seems to be windy on recycling day when the contents in blue boxes can often be found blowing onto our streets and neighbour's properties. To help prevent this from happening, here are a few suggestions to keep blue box contents in their place:



- Place heavier items such as books and magazines on top of the lighter items. Bundle cardboard and newspapers separately. These bundles can act as a 'lid' for your blue box
- Consider putting your recycling boxes out for collection in the morning, rather than the night before or skip that week's collection and place your recycling out for following week if your blue boxes aren't full
- Don't overfill your blue box, keep material below the rim to prevent the wind from catching it and blowing it out of the bin. There is no limit for the number of blue boxes put out for weekly collection. Additional blue boxes can be purchased at our Customer Service Department
- You may also take your recycling to one of York Region's Recycling Depots located across the region. More information can be found on page 3 of the Recycling and Waste Collection Calendar or on the Town's website.

BASKETBALL NETS ON THE ROAD

Basketball nets are not permitted on any road within the Town of Whitchurch-Stouffville. These nets are a safety hazard to other residents/vehicles and interfere with Town operations such as waste collection.

Residents are asked to remove these structures immediately. Failure to do so may result in the Town removing them as per By-law No. 2012-136-RE and invoicing the homeowner accordingly.
