Young adults 22 and younger are invited to write their best prose for the sixth annual short story contest hosted by the Canadian Federation of University Women.

The competition, co-ordinated by the federation's Aurora/Newmarket chapter, is open to aspiring scribes in York Region and Bradford West Gwillimbury, writing contest committee chairperson Adele Matsalla said.

While creative writing can be a solitary and challenging task, the contest rules are simple.

Submissions must be accompanied with a \$5 entry fee and can be no longer than 750 words, so ensure you do a word count.

The deadline for entries is

Feb. 15, 2016.

Cash prizes for first, second and third places are \$400, \$300 and \$200 respectively. Winners will be announced in April and the top story will be reprinted in the Newmarket Era and Aurora Banner newspapers.

This year, award-winning Canadian author and playwright Jennifer Dance will be the celebrity judge.

The Aurora/Newmarket chapter's goal is to promote literacy and encourage young writers and is part of a national organization.
