Hospital parking fee drop applauded

Perseverance has paid off after the province announced this week it will lower hospital parking rates.

Stouffville resident John Hazlewood along with other local citizens as the Fair Hospital Parking Charges advocacy group — has advocated, since 2011, for lower parking fees,

through meetings with officials, municipal councils and provincial legislators.

This week, Newmarket-Aurora MPP Chris Ballard announced at the Central LHIN office in Markham that, beginning Oct. 1, hospitals that charge more than \$10 a day for parking must provide five-day, 10-day and 30-day passes that are 50-per-cent less than their daily rate, transferable between patients and caregivers,

allow in-and-out privileges in a 24-hour period and valid for one year.

"The ability to transfer parking passes between family members will go a long way toward helping families visit loved ones in hospital," Hazlewood said.
