2016 INTERIM TAXES DUE DATE April 15, 2016

Supplementary Taxes on Newly-Constructed Homes

Owners have been or will be receiving tax bills for the value of the "land" only excluding building, until the house is assessed by the Municipal Property Assessment Corporation (MPAC). Once assessed, supplementary tax bills will be issued for the house, retroactive to the date of possession. To estimate the annual taxes, simply multiply the purchase price of the home x 1%. This process can take 2 to 3 years and the tax bills will be due within a short time period. Pre-payments on account or through a preauthorized payment plan can be made to assist homeowners in planning for these future supplementary tax bills. REMINDERS FOR RECYCLING ON WINDY DAYS

- Place heavier items such as books and magazines on top of the lighter items. This should help prevent light blue box materials (such as paper) from blowing out of the bin and littering the streets.
- Bundle cardboard and newspapers separately. These bundles can act as a 'lid' for your blue box.
- On windy days, consider putting your recycling boxes out for collection in the morning, rather than the night before or skip that week's collection and place your recycling out for following week if your blue boxes aren't full.
- Don't overfill your blue box, keep material below the rim to prevent the wind from catching it and blowing it out of the bin. There is no limit for the number of blue boxes put out for weekly collection. Additional blue boxes can be purchased at our Customer Service Department located at the Municipal Offices at 111 Sandiford Drive, Monday – Friday 8 am – 5 pm.
