At the Council meeting scheduled for May 17, 2016, consideration will be given to the proposed amendment of the General Fees and Charges By-law 2015-134-FI. Staff have reviewed the road occupancy permit fees used by other area municipalities. Staff recommend that a Road Occupancy Fee of \$10/square metre/month be applied for occupation of boulevards, sidewalks and on-street parking spaces, and a fee \$30/lane/day for road closures.
