Truck rollover knocks out power

A tanker truck driver sustained minor injuries after his vehicle rolled over near the Davis Drive and Warden Avenue intersection in northern Whitchurch-Stouffville yesterday morning.

York Regional Police were called to the scene of the single-vehicle crash at about 6:45 a.m.

The truck flipped on its side and hit a hydro pole, knocking out power to about 200 residents in the area on the East Gwillimbury border, according to an outage map on Hydro One's website.

It also closed the road to traffic.

The cause of the crash is still under investigation, York Const. Andy Pattenden said.

"I don't know what happened. He drove off the road or swerved for a deer, I have no idea," he said.
