## Mild hiring climate forecast in York

York Region should expect a mild hiring climate for the third quarter of 2016, according to the latest Manpower Employment Out-

Ten per cent of employers are looking to hire new staff between July and September and none plan to cut employees, says Maple Kyriacou of Manpower's York office. Ninety per cent plan to maintain current staffing levels.

Nationally, employment gains are expected to be modest in the third quarter, Darlene Minatel, vice-president of Manpower Cana-

da's operations and strategic accounts. "However, we are seeing some bright spots," she said. "The dollar's prolonged low has been good news for the manufacturing industry. Increased demand for Canadian exports is a big reason the manufacturingdurables sector is expecting the largest quarterly employment growth of any sector for Q3 (the third quarter).

Overall, the survey of 1,900 employers across Canada revealed 16 per cent plan to hire workers from July to September, while 5 per cent expect cutbacks.
