Currently, the operator imports clean fill for the gravel pit under the town's site alteration by-law 2014-101-RE. The current plan requires an assessment of each source site of excess fill

to the property.

While the regulation works for large-scale infrastructure projects that generate the bulk of excess fill, it is not practical for smallscale construction projects that take days to complete, a press release from the town says. The town will test all sources of stockpile to meet standards of acceptable qualitv.
