### Hathaway 10th on Quebec track

Jason Hathaway drove the Stouffville-based T3R/EHR Raybestos/Fast Eddie/Choko/HGC Chevrolet to a 10th-place finish at the NASCAR Pinty's Lucas Oil 250 event at the Autodrome St. Eustache track in St. Eustache, Que. Saturday.

But it could have been a far better result were it not for some adversity Hathaway was forced to overcome in a race in which his vehicle spun out on a couple of occasions after rival drivers made contact with him.

Maneuvering his way into second place by lap 177, adversity struck Hathaway when he was spun again by a rival car and finished 10th.

"We had a great car tonight. It's a shame

some drivers can't just be patient and smart all at the same time," he said.

"When you come up on one driver every lap and wonder how he is going to race you or wreck you, it isn't good for the sport. NASCAR can only officiate so much and the rest is up to us as drivers to settle on the track.

"Our team did an awesome job dealing with what was put in front of us and I'm proud to have them behind me. They showed class and calibre," he said in a press release.

Cayden Lapceвич took the checkered flag and leads the overall series with 462 points and one race remaining.

Hathaway is in ninth place with 353 points.

The final scheduled event will be the Kawartha 250 at the Kawartha Speedway in Fraserville this Saturday.
