Canadian folk singer and songwriter Dave Gunning is set to spark Stouffville's fall entertainment options with his concert this Saturday, Sept. 24. Tickets are \$19 and the concert starts at 8 p.m.

Gunning's music career has yielded him eight East Coast Music Awards, two Canadian Folk Music Awards, and a 2012 Juno Award nomination

For November, local musician Dave Lawlor will perform a concert in support of York Region Victim Services. The evening will have a reception with wine and hors d'oeuvres at 6:30 p.m. followed by the concert at 8 p.m. Tickets are \$100 plus tax.

Ending the season before Christmas events is Canadian vocal group DALA.
