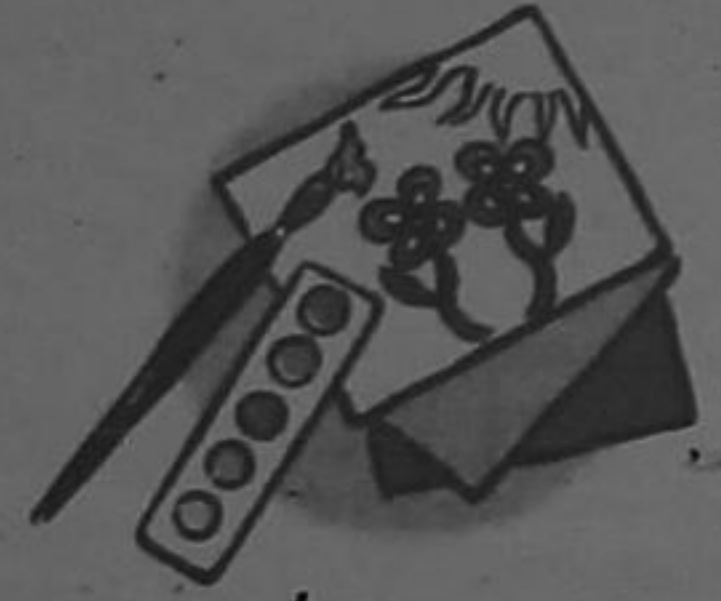
LATCHAM GALLERY WINTER BREAK CAMP DAYS
