# Outdoor Water Use For The Communities Of Stouffville, Ballantrae And Musselman's Lake May 15 through September 30

Conserving water is important for our communities, it helps to protect our environment, our water resources and saves energy.

Help us conserve water by following the Towns Outdoor Water Use. By-law which restricts the use of the municipal water supply from a hose, pipe, sprinkler or permanent water irrigation system for the purpose of watering any lawn, garden or the washing of vehicles, sidewalks or driveways or the filling of swimming pools except as follows:

An EVEN numbered address may use water outdoors
ONLY ON EVEN NUMBERED DAYS of the month.
An ODD numbered address may use water outdoors

ONLY ON ODD NUMBERED DAYS of the month.

During your designated day, outdoor water use is only permitted between the hours of 6 a.m. to 10 a.m. and 6 p.m. to 10 p.m.



#### COUNCIL HIGHLIGHT

#### Mayor, Fire Chief And Town Recognized By Royal Canadian Air Cadets

Town of Whitchurch-Stouffville Mayor Wayne Emmerson and Fire and Emergency Services Chief Rob McKenzie were both honoured and presented with certificates by representatives of the 707 Marion Orr Air Cadet Squadron for their contribution and support of the group. Chief McKenzie was also made an honorary Air Cadet.

#### Skateboard Park Naming Honours Mayor

Town Council unanimously supported a motion naming the new skateboard facility adjacent to the Whitchurch-Stouffville Leisure Centre and Library in honour of Mayor Wayne Emmerson. The facility, to be named the Wayne Emmerson Skateboard Park, was made possible by the Mayor's fundraising efforts through his golf tournament and commitment to youth-focused programming and Town amenities.

#### Stouffville Pentecostal Church Site Plan Approved

Town Council approved the site plan for the Stouffville Pentecostal Church which permits the construction of a new one-story place of worship at the northeast corner of Hoover Park Drive and Sandiford Drive. Once built, the Church will feature space for a daycare, youth and adult programs as well as a food bank.

#### Sidewalk Winter Maintenance Contract Awarded

Town Council approved the awarding of the sidewalk winter maintenance and snow windrow clearing program contract to Todd Brothers Contracting Limited.

The Town's sidewalk winter maintenance program involves four rubber-tired tractors, operators, complete with power reversible blades, sanders and blowers to be used for clearing of sidewalks at locations determined by the Town. Windrow removal involves the clearing of snow that accumulates at the end of driveways during road plowing, where required, for residents eligible under the Town's program.

## Community Track and Tennis Court Refurbishment Project Nearing Completion

Town Council received a report on the Community Track and Tennis Court refurbishment project which is nearing completion.

Located at 12483 Ninth Line (Stouffville Arena and Sport Field Property) in the Community of Stouffville, the facility is now open to the public.

Refurbishment consisted of resurfacing the existing community track and three tennis courts, as well as the creation of a fourth tennis court and lighting system upgrades.

Funding for the project was on a shared basis between the Town and the Federal Government through their sponsored.

Community Infrastructure Improvement Fund.

#### 2015 Pan American Games Torch Relay Coming To Whitchurch-Stouffville

Town Council approved the signing of a Memorandum of Understanding between the Town and the Toronto Organizing . Committee for the 2015 Pan American and Parapan American Games (TO2015) which will see the torch relay come through the Town of Whitehurch-Stouffville.

The 2015 Pan American Games is being field July 10 to July 26 and the 2015 Parapan American Games is being August 7 to August 15, in the City of Toronto.
