



Stouffville's Men of Note chorus packed up and took their act to Europe this. summer, performing in historic cathedrals, magnificent caves and the Vienna Opera House.

In the water taxi gliding along to St. Mark's Basilica in Venice, Italy, the home grown choir engaged in an impromptu 'sing off' with a choir from Poland. On their 12-day concert tour to Italy, Slovenia, Austria and the Czech Republic, the Men of Note were accompanied by enough family and friends to fill their tour bus, including choir director Oksana Vignan and accompanist Linda Marcinkus.

The group was awed by their chance to sing during the evening mass at St. Mark's Basilica, which dates from the 11th century.

When the congregation broke out into applause, it was a moment the group will never forget. The occasion was "very, very special," said Men of Note concert director, Vince Parry.

"You take a little train that drives you two kilometres into the bowels of the earth," explained Mr. Parry. "It is bigger than the biggest cathedral you have ever been in."

When the choir reached a gigantic part of the cave called The Concert Hall, they were so moved they started singing When I Survey the Wondrous Cross.

They also performed in the neo-Gothic St. Martin's Parish Church in the town of Bled, at Bad Tatzmannsdorf in Austria and "the choir sang a rousing final concert at the Church of St. Katherine of Alexandria in Prague," recalled Gord Bibby, the group's president, in an e-mail.

The tour wrapped up with a private Dvorak chamber concert.


