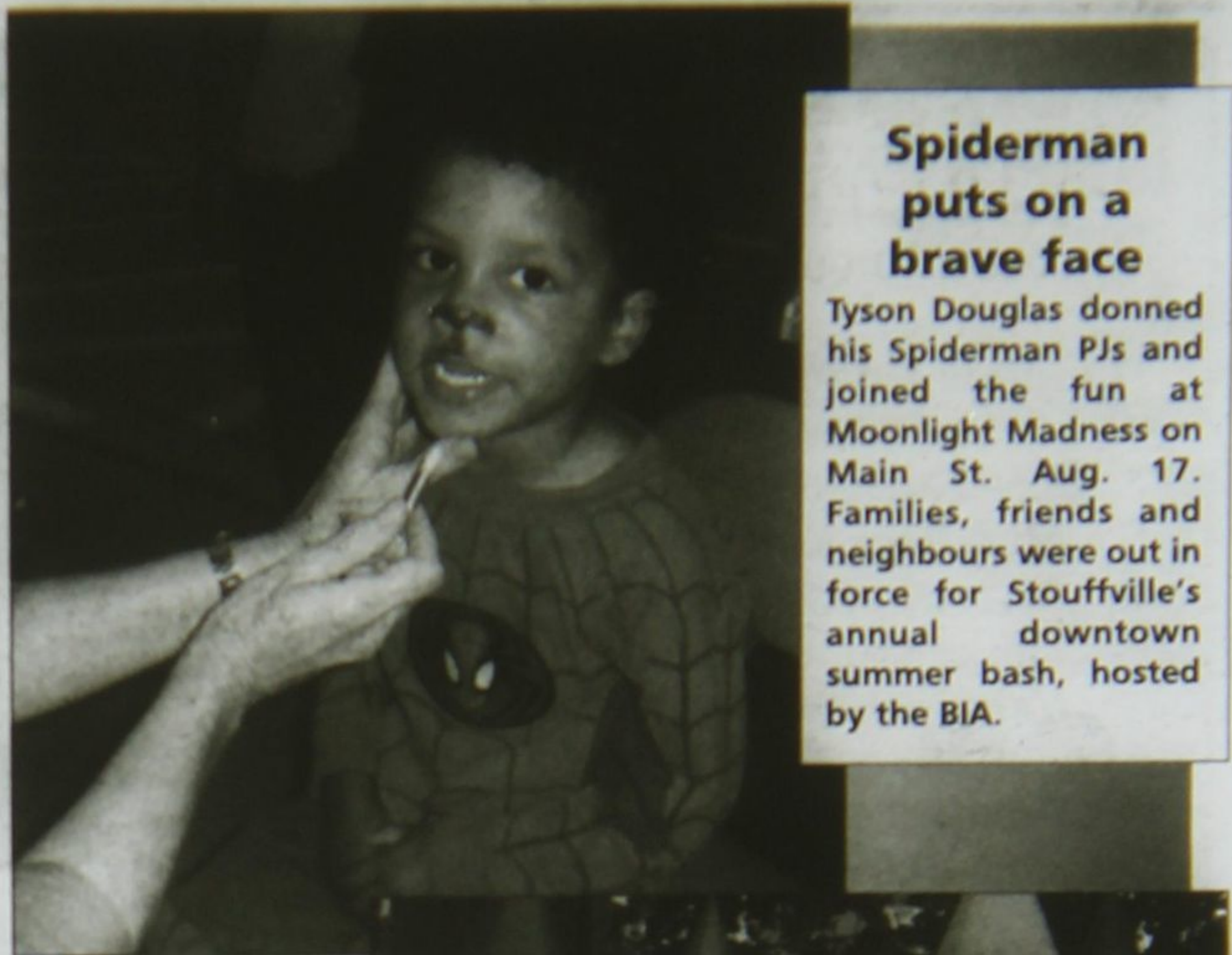


## Getting back to their roots
