The card will advise the following:

- Ward number, poll number, school support and resident status
- Voting location
- Advance vote dates and locations

Voter Identification

When you arrive at the voting place, you must show identification to prove that you are the person whose name appears on the Voters' list. The identification must show your name and qualifying address in Whitchurch-Stouffville. Photo identification is not required. There are many documents that can be used to show your name and address, including:

- an Ontario driver's license
- an Ontario health card (if your name and address are printed on the card)
- a mortgage, lease or rental agreement
- an insurance policy
- a credit card statement
- a bill for hydro, water, gas, telephone, cable TV


For municipal election purposes, a Canadian passport is not an acceptable document, because you write your address inside your passport yourself.


