YARD WASTE COLLECTION

Yard Waste is collected bi-weekly on your regular collection day from April to November.

All yard waste material except brush must be placed in paper yard waste bags or an open top container (excluding cardboard boxes and blue boxes). Clear, opaque or orange bags will not be collected.

Materials acceptable for collection include leaves, plants,

fine brush, tree clippings, and branches. Branches are not to exceed 100 mm (4") in diameter, and shall be tied in bundles of a maximum length of 1.2 metres (4'), and weighing no more than 22 kgs (50 lbs.). Please do not use wire to tie bundles.

Materials not accepted include grass clippings, stumps, root balls, rocks, food and kitchen wastes, animal droppings, fruit and vegetables, driveway and road sweepings.

Residents who wish to drop off their yard waste (including grass clippings) may do so at the Miller Waste Composting Facility, 1351 Bloomington Road, Richmond Hill (just west of Leslie Street) Monday to Saturday - 7:30 a.m. to 5 p.m. (closed Statutory Holidays). Fees may apply.

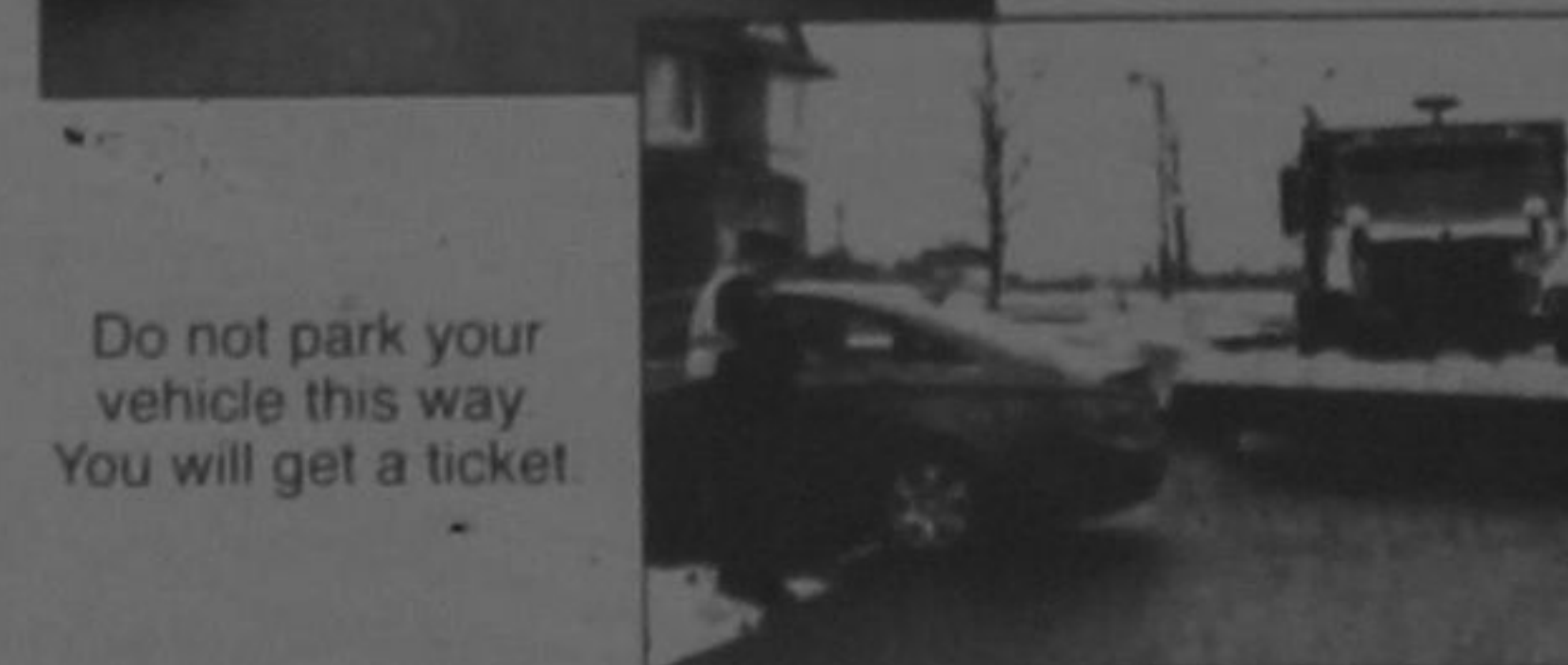
HELP US KEEP THE ROADS CLEAR

Parking on both sides of the streets restricts access for emergency vehicles and snow plows. Help us keep the roads clear by NOT parking directly opposite a car that is already parked on the road. It is very difficult and sometimes not possible to get our emergency vehicles and snow plows through cars parked this way on our residential streets.

How can you help us? When parking, ask yourself if your vehicle will block the passage of an emergency vehicle or snow plow. Wherever possible, please park in your garage or fully on your driveway.
