Following his accident, Luke spent a month at Vancouver General Hospital before

being flown home and admitted to St. Michael's Hospital in Toronto Nov. 29. He was moved from St. Michael's to Lyndhurst Lodge Dec. 16 to begin his program of rehabilitation.

His transfer to the lodge, which specializes in rehabilitation for spinal cord injuries, was originally scheduled for Dec. 9, but had to be postponed because of an outbreak of the Norwalk virus.
