Rotary is an international service association whose main purpose is to encourage high ethical standards in all vocations in order to help build goodwill and peace in the world. Its members represent a cross-section of a community's business and professional men and women. Rotary boasts 1.2 million members in over 30,000 clubs worldwide.

Rotary has championed many causes since its inception in 1905. Among these is its pledge to eradicate polio from the world in time for the 100th anniversary of Rotary in 2005. The task is already 98% complete thanks to a program of global mass immunization that has seen as many as 27 million children treated in a single day in India.

Rotary is also committed to a worldwide literacy program based upon the principle that every child in the world should have access to books and

knowledge.

While the Rotary Club of Stouffville was chartered May 6, 1998, the Club actually began its service mandate in 1997. Among the projects tackled that year were the refurbishing of the benches in the Stouffville Cemetery and the gathering of 1,500 pounds of food for the Whitchurch-Stouffville Food Bank. The club established a connection with the Rotary Club in Santos, Brazil in November 1997, collecting 1,100 small toys for distribution in a children's hospital and a home for underprivileged children in Santos. Stouffville club member Mary Francis Juk took the toys to Santos in 1997, and returned with another 1,400 toys from the Club this Christmas. The Stouffville and Santos clubs continue to engage in international exchanges as well as exchanges of ideas and cultures.

Since its inception, the Stouffville Club has distributed hundreds of books in countries such as India and Haiti. Local projects have included the holding of Bird House Auction fundraisers, the refurbishing of the Memorial Park Diamond One bleachers, and the cleanup of Lehman's Pond each spring. Club members have served as marshals at the Town's annual Strawberry Festival, and the Club hosted an Evening of Illusion at the 2001 Festival.

The Club is to hold its second annual "A Taste of Spring" fundraiser at the Sleepy Hollow Golf and Country Club March 31 2003. The gala includes live entertainment, a silent auction, draws, food and wine tasting. The 2002 inaugural raised \$9,000 with 240 people attending.

Stouffville Club membership currently stands at 20 members with Ruth Boynton serving as president. New members are always welcome. The Club meets Tuesday mornings at 7:15 a.m. in the Garden View Terrace Restaurant at Parkview Village.


