Despite the necessity of requiring a handicapped tag, my mother lives alone and is a strong and independent 75-yearold. She goes to visit my father daily and helps care for him at Bloomington Cove, where he is restricted to a wheelchair. You see, our whole family understands and respects what the handicapped reserved areas represent. She unselfishly devotes both at her time volunteering Bloomington Cove and Stouffville Hospital.

She was quite shaken up after her encounter with you and called me at work when she got home. I told her it wasn't worth getting upset over, but after our conversation I became incensed enough to write this letter. I only wish I had the opportunity to tell you in person about the frightening effect this incident had on her. How dare you, in your ignorance, undermine her independence. Will she now think twice about venturing out alone? You can bet the thought of strangers like you will be on her mind.
