Stouffville Legion member John Chalmers received a Certificate of Merit from the Royal Canadian Legion Ontario Command for collecting the largest single amount for poppy sales in the region during the 2002 Remembrance Day campaign.

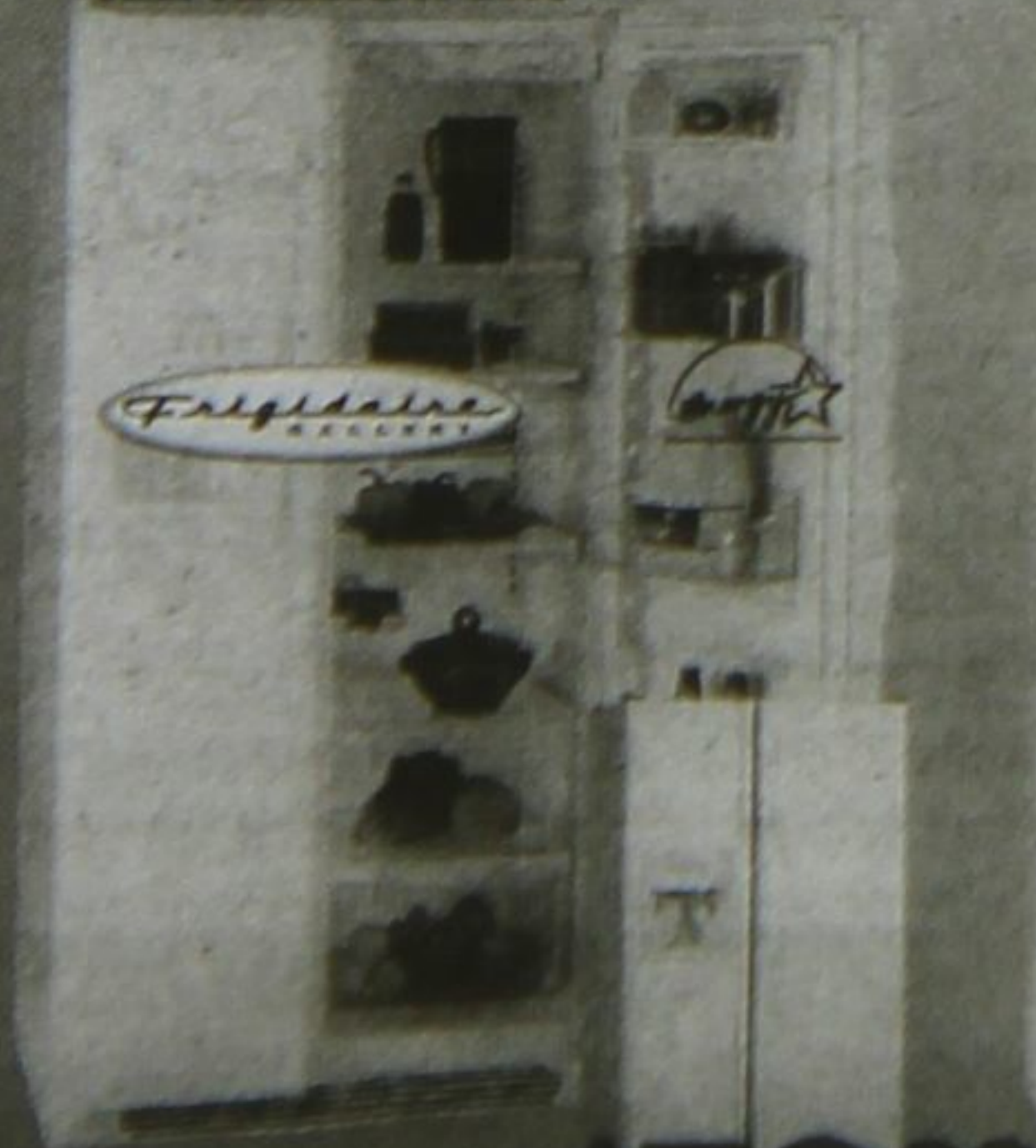

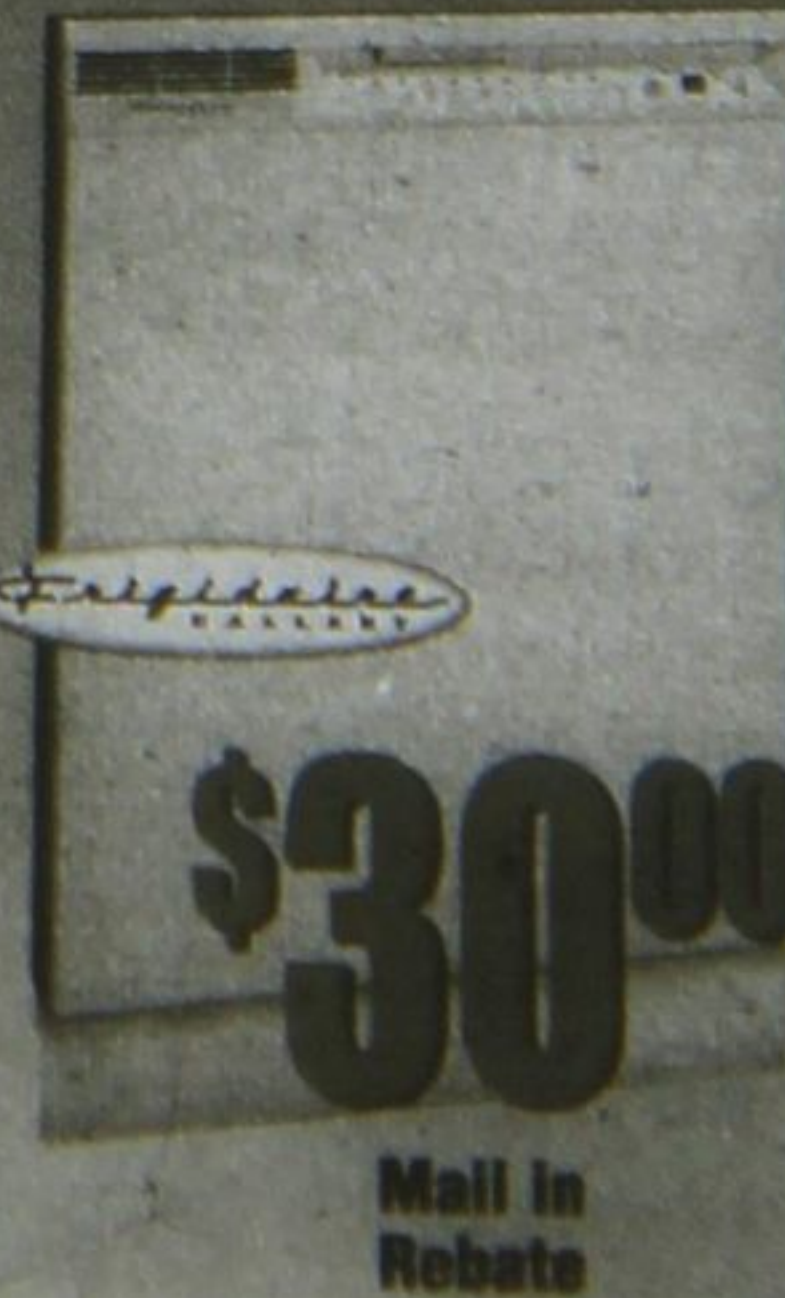
