"Bringing you the World by the Board Foot"

We like this by-line for it explains something of Century Mill Lumber. However, for some of our readers (all 3 1/2 of them), it is confusing.

1. "Bringing the world" indicates that some of our lumber is of a foreign nature, coming from places such as Brazil and Cameroon. We sell species from Avodire to Zebra wood. If these are novel woods to you, I suggest initial use be limited to accent pieces in your "objet d'art".
  2. "By the Board Foot" indicates the measuring method used. A Board Foot is the equivalent to 1" thick x 12" wide x 12" long. Example - a board 1 1/2" x 6" x 4".
- One formula: a) convert all fractions to decimals and all numbers to inches, b) multiply the 3 numbers and divide by 144

$$(1.5 \times 6 \times 48) = 3 \text{ bd. ft.}$$
