After disposing of all his opponents in masterful fashion in his Toronto bouts of late, Jim McMillen, one of the cageyest wrestlers in the game to-day, finally achieved his goal two weeks ago, when in defeating George Zaharias in the roughest and most exciting bout seen in many a day, he also gained a chance at the World's Title held by Jim Browning. Both men came to terms with promoter Jack Corcoran of the Queensbury Club after he had outbid the New York promoters. Since his return to Toronto ring last fall, McMillen has appeared in many thrilling bouts; he is heavier and more experienced than before, he has also adopted a style of wrestling which tends to incur the fans displeasure and also tends to get his opponents "goat". Many of the fans have howled and hooted derision at McMillen for the sly tricks which, while not legal, are not really considered rough.

McMillen is at his best when wrestling scientific men, as witness the splendid bout which he and Gino Garibaldi put on not so long ago. In the heavy going, his football training stands him in good stead and when riled can hand out plenty of punishment, this he proved against Zaharias, when he defeated the "bad man" at his own game.

The bouts will be held next Wednesday night March 14th, instead of the usual Thursday night, in Maple Leaf Gardens and there will be no advance in prices for this world's championship bout. Promoter Corcoran has also arranged for an all star supporting card.


