Capt. Horace Griffey returned home from overseas on the Mauretania, arriving in Caledonia on Thursday evening of last week. Capt. Griffey enlisted in April 1942 and was posted as instructor to the basic training centre at Simcoe. He was commissioned in 1943, and went overseas in July 1944. On arrival overseas he transferred to the Argyll and Sutherlands. He was wounded in battle at the Albert Canal in Belgium in September 1944. Capt. Griffey was with his unit in Germany on V-E Day. He served with the "Argylls" on occupational duty until November 1945 when his unit returned to England.
