New York, March 31.—The St. Lawrence power company, of Massena county, N.Y., is to be re-organized, and thereby hangs a tale of the development of a great water power.

LONDON, Ont., March 31.—London has been visited by many magicians, showmen, lecturers, sect-makers, but she has been edified during the past week by the herald of the strangest doctrine that has ever been heard in any Canadian city.
