SUBMIT A BY-LAW

At Once For Purchase of the Lighting Plants.

In discussing with a Whig reporter the situation existing between the city and the Light, Heat and Power Company, one of Kingston's most prominent citizens, a man of unbiased opinion, suggested that the city council should at once submit a by-law to the people, authorizing the purchase of the lighting plants for the amount of the arbitrators' award, \$170,000, and include in the by-law the proviso that in case it should finally be decided by the courts that the company is entitled to a franchise consideration, the sum of \$80,000, agreed upon by the arbitrators, be then paid over.
