STRUCK VITAL POINT. How New Grain Duties Affect Cobden's.

THE WAY IS NOW OPENED FOR REVISION OF THE ENTIRE TARIFF SYSTEM.

Prevailing Opinion In Britain—Colonial Questions To Be Discussed—The New Tax Has Opened Up the Way For Preferential Discussion.

New York, April 16.—A Tribune cable from London says: "Despite all efforts to minimize the importance of the revival of registration duties on grain and flour, it is evident that a new departure has been made in the direction of a revenue tariff. The duties may be small and bakers may be unable to raise the price of bread, but Cobdenism has been struck at a most vital point. If small duties can be placed on food stuffs, they can also be levied on many commodities for revenue purposes.
