OBJECT TO THE WORDS

That Republics Must Forfeit Independence.

HOW SOME BOERS REGARD IT

A PLAN TO GET AROUND THE OBJECTIONS.

It is suggested that Britain enter into a treaty for the incorporation of the Two Republics with the British Empire.
 London, April 25.—The Pall Mall Gazette publishes a statement from a reliable and trustworthy correspondent at The Hague, who claims that he represents the views of the Dutch government in the matter of the Dutch Republics. The statement is that the Dutch government is "greatly concerned" in the way of peace, the correspondent says, "lies in the form of the words, that the republics must forfeit their independence, and unless this difficulty can be got over by the use of a different phrase or phrases, the Netherlands government are not very hopeful of the termination of the war at present."
 "While some of the Boer leaders are highly educated and intelligent men, and realize that their independence must be forfeited, many of their followers are rough and ignorant, and these latter have had the words 'independence' so drilled into their ears since the Marjuba fiasco, when many of them were children, that many would never consent to forfeit it."
 "There should, however, be no great difficulty in arranging this matter if the British would agree to leave out the objectionable words altogether and attain what would practically be the same end, by, for example, entering into a treaty for the incorporation of the two republics with the British empire, or some similar phrase which would give the lower class Boers an idea that they were not being swallowed up."
 The discussion last evening in the commons, by Mr. Morley and Sir William Harcourt on the arrest and imprisonment of editor Cartwright, in South Africa, was an acid one.
 The government easily defeated Mr. Morley's motion to adjourn the house in order to call attention to the matter but it is regarded as significant that the liberals were supported by such unopponents as Gibson Bowles, Winston Churchill, Mr. V. Russell, while many others declined to vote.

BOGGS IS FREE AGAIN.

Convicted of Embezzling \$107,000 Of Bank Funds.

RELEASED FROM PRISON.

DOVER RESIDENTS AWAIT HIS RETURN HOME.

His Defalcations Proved to Be a Great Scandal in Delaware—His Ability Was Well Evidenced By the Manner of His Plans.

Dover, Del., April 25.—William N.
