THE MACHINIST TROUBLE.

A WRITER OFFERS AN ARGUMENT TO THE MEN.

The Kingston Workmen at the Locomotive Works, He Says, Have a Tremendous Responsibility.

Kingston, May 6.—(To the Editor): I have no first-hand knowledge of the matter of striking in the locomotive works, but I understand that one of the points at issue is the employment on machines of men who have not the standing of machinists.

I have lately been studying with some fullness the competition of the United States with Britain in many manufactures in which Britain was formerly supreme the United States has surpassed her and threatens to leave her far in the rear.

A particular case in point was where a British firm tendered for the construction of a bridge in one of the British colonies. The firm allowed only five per cent. margin for profit and contingencies, because they had six hundred employees, and barely enough work.

Before closing I may say that though what I have written above represents the attitude of the greater number of the British workmen, yet some of them are becoming aware of their true interests, and there has lately been an agreement drawn up between the manufacturer of machinery and the machinists.
