THE LATE JOHN STACEY

HE HAD LONG BEEN A RESIDENT OF KINGSTON. He Tells of His Life in the Army and in the Police Force—His Remains Now Lie in Cataract Valley.

The Whig has been furnished with the following article, which describes itself: "Kingston, Aug. 20th, 1906. John Stacey, ex-policeman, residing on Alfred street, arrived in this city fifty years ago to-day, having come in 1847. I was born August 29th, 1821, at Hyde Heath, in the parish of Chessham, Buckinghamshire, England. I enlisted on March 29th, 1840, in the 2nd battalion, rifle brigade, stationed at Windsor, England; served with the regiment six months in England, one year in Wales, one year in Bermuda, four years in Halifax, Nova Scotia, one year in Montreal, four years and eight months in Kingston.
