PRINCIPAL GRANT DEAD

He Passed Away At Eleven O'clock To-Day. A SKETCH OF HIS CAREER.

BORN IN THE PROVINCE OF BRAINY MEN.

Brilliant College Career—Educated in Scotland—His Work in the Ministry—Called to Queen's in 1877.

Principal Grant's condition changed early this morning, evidence of oedema of the lungs developing.

His Life Briefly Outlined. Principal Grant was born on December 22nd, 1835, at Stellarton.

His father, a native of Scotland, taught a school in the village where the distinguished principal was born.

Among the principal's publications are "New Year Sermons," "Reformers of the 19th Century," "Advantages of Imperial Federation."
