WAS A MIGHTY STRUGGLE BRIEF HISTORY OF THE WAR NOW ENDED.

Clash of British and Burgers Over the Franchise For Foreigners Led to Hostilities Which Have Lasted For Two And One-Half Years.

The direct cause of the war in South Africa was the refusal of the Transvaal government to allow the foreign element of the population to have a voice in public affairs, accompanied by a like refusal to continue in force certain railway and other public utility franchises held mainly by British subjects.

It was in 1837, when the British assumed authority over Cape Colony to protect the settlers from the warlike Kaffirs, that the Dutch began to plan to set up a government of their own. They moved toward the interior to accomplish this purpose, and, after the second Kaffir war of 1847, when the British frontier was extended to the Kier river, they moved toward the interior again.

Kruger Sends Ultimatum. After a series of conferences between Mr. Kruger's government and Sir Alfred Milner, in October, 1899, which bore no fruit, the Boer president sent an ultimatum to the British on October 10th of that year, demanding an evacuation of the therefore Boer territory.

While the British were hastening their armies to the front, White at Ladysmith, Baden-Powell at Mafeking and Buller at Kimberley, under the actual if not the nominal command of Cecil Rhodes in person, were defending their positions, with occasional sorties to harass the besiegers.
