OCCURRING IN COURSE OF BRITISH CORONATIONS.

Death Bed Scene of Edward The Confessor—Falling of The Crown Off the Head of James II.

The coronation of Stephen heralded a wretchedly unfortunate reign, and certainly the actual events of the ceremony seemed to betoken it full measure.

For some reason or other, the utmost pains and expences were lavished upon the coronation of Richard II., and a coronation conducted upon a scale never before witnessed in England.

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The sceptre with the dove was an emblem of peace. It denoted more particularly the peace which descended upon the land when, after the stormy days of Danish invasion and English surrender, good King Edward the Confessor came to rule over the people of this country.

Charles I.'s coronation was further distinguished by a most unfortunate sermon. Senhouse, bishop of Carlisle, was the preacher. He selected for his text the words, "I will give thee a crown of life."

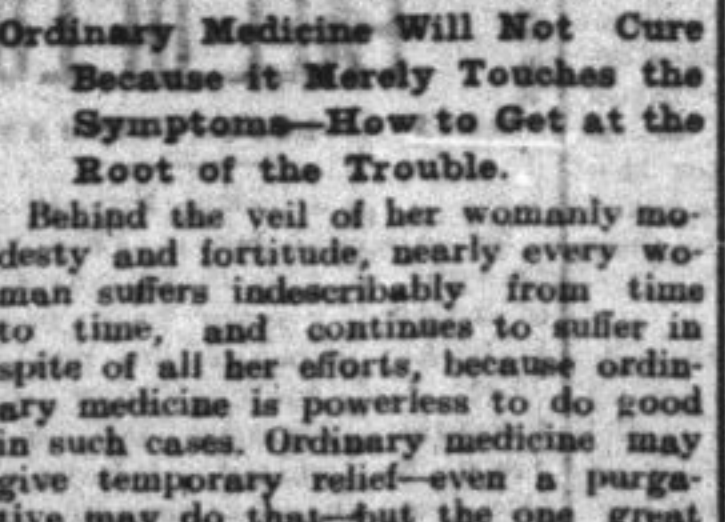

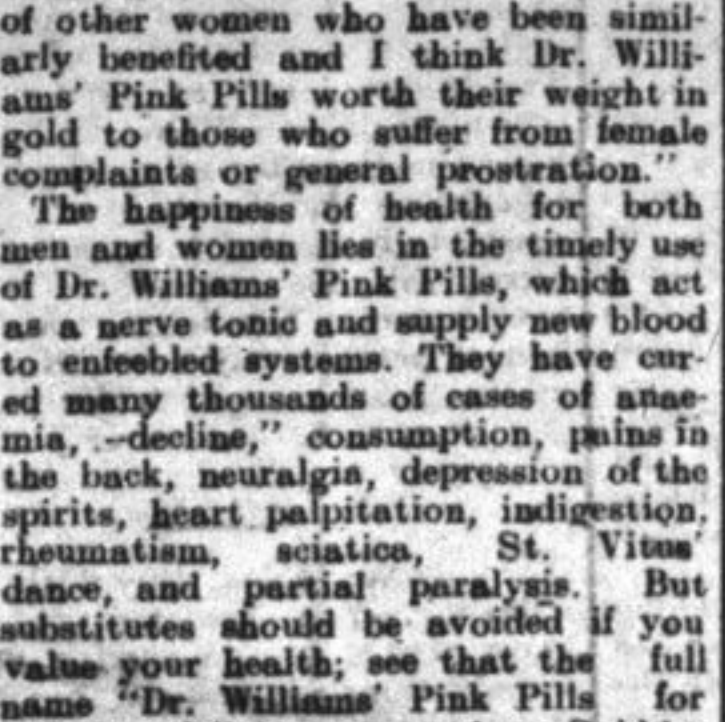

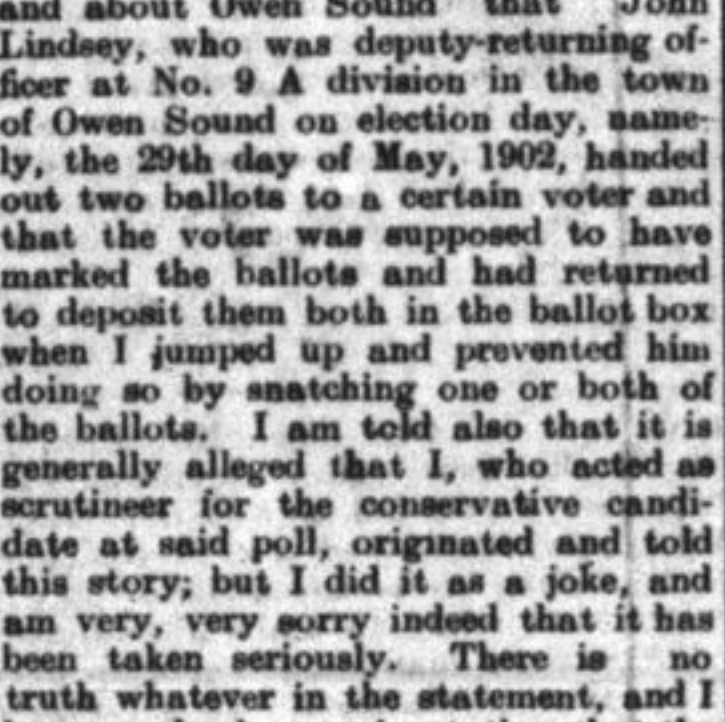
