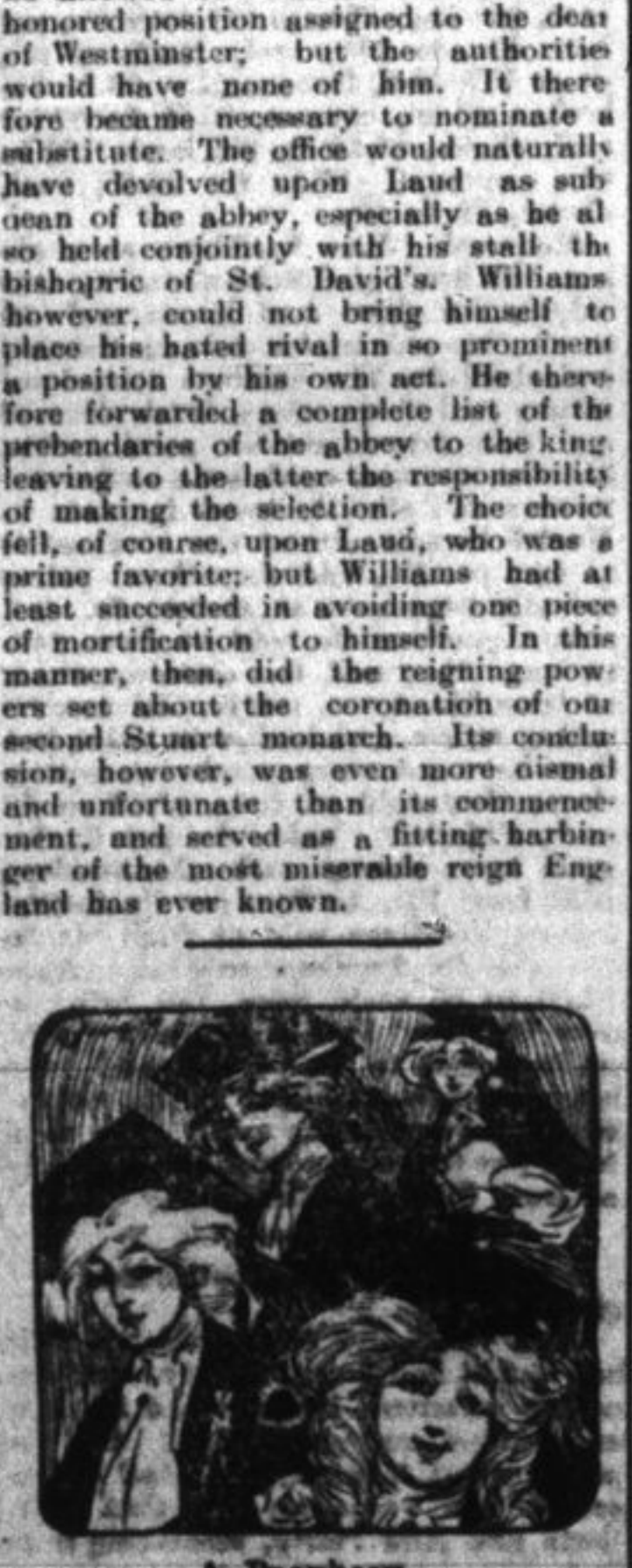

Big Bridge At Waco. Waco, Texas, June 10.—The magnificent new steel bridge over the Brazos, one of the largest in the United States, was formally opened to traffic today.
