A BRUSH UP ON AFRICA. A THOROUGH AND CONDENSED HISTORY.

Volume ten of the Canadian Nineteenth Century series, Linscott Publishing Company, Toronto, is a timely contribution to the invaluable history.

One hundred years ago South Africa south of the Zambesi was the greater part an unknown land; the Dutch and Portuguese had few settlements or military posts.

A very interesting description is given of the three great classes of natives, Bushmen, Hottentots, Bantus.

Christ Church, Brixton, England, has received a legacy of \$50,000.

Mormons claim to have 3,000 missionaries in the field, and to have made 20,000 converts last year.

Rev. W. C. McIntyre, late of Queen's, has been extended a unanimous call to the Boscawen Presbyterian church.

Rev. J. E. Herbison, B.A., a graduate of Queen's, has been called to the pastorate of the Highland Park Presbyterian church, Denver, Col.

The Anglican diocesan synod of Victoria has admitted ladies to membership in vestries.

An able missionary of the London society in China says that it is estimated that China spends annually in ancestral worship one hundred and fifty millions of dollars.

Rev. J. E. Mercur, E. F. Every, and Archdeacon Churton were consecrated Bishops of Tasmania, Falkland Isles and Nassau, respectively, in St. Paul's cathedral, on Sunday, July 13th.

Rev. Canon Palham has succeeded to the earldom of Chichester. The other five peers in the ministry are the Marquis of Normandy, Earls of Devon, Stratford and Bessborough and Lord Seaford.

The first Protestant converts in Japan were baptized thirty-six years ago, and the first church of nine members was organized twenty-nine years ago.

At the age of seventy-six the venerable Apostle of the New Hebrides, Dr. John G. Paton, has been so far restored to health as to return, with his devoted wife, to his work on the Island of Aniwa.

There are 267 retired ministers, 213 widows and 67 children dependent on the superannuation fund of the Methodist church, which necessitates an expenditure of \$125,000 yearly.

The people of the United States gave last year for foreign missions the sum of \$5,828,316; England gave \$7,752,618; Scotland, \$1,467,236; Wales, \$51,685; and Canada \$296,575.

There are 3,413 churches, an increase of 84 over last year. The number of parsonages is 1,208, an increase of 75.
