Montreal, Aug. 18. -There were about 900 head of butchers' cattle, 150 head and 1,500 sheep and lambs of forest at the East End abattoir today. The butchers were out strong, and bought freely, but the prices continue very low, and unsatisfactory to the drovers. A few of the best cattle were sold at from 44c to 47c, per lb., and from that down to 34c for pretty good stock; common cattle were very hard to sell, and prices ranged from 24c to 34c, per lb., with the lean canners at from 17c to 26c, per lb. A considerable number will have to be held over for another market.
