Mrs. Florence Turner, Buffalo, left for home on Thursday after a two months' stay at Mr. and Mrs. J. F. Clark's.

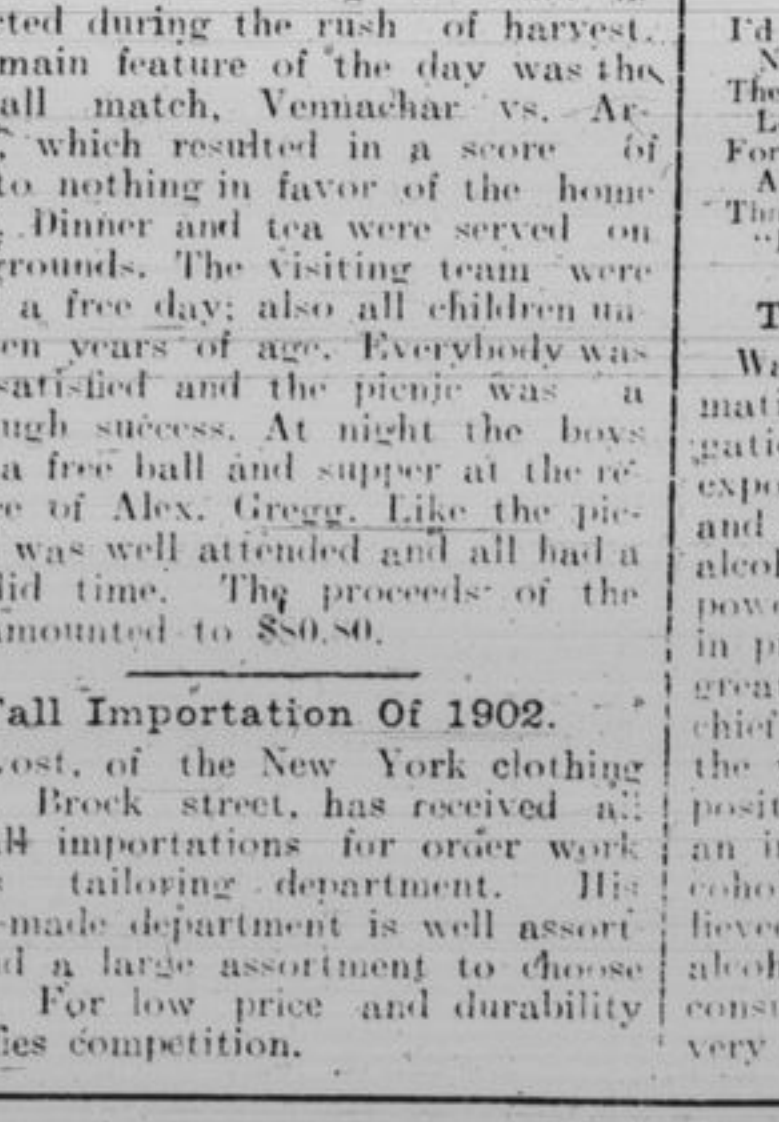
