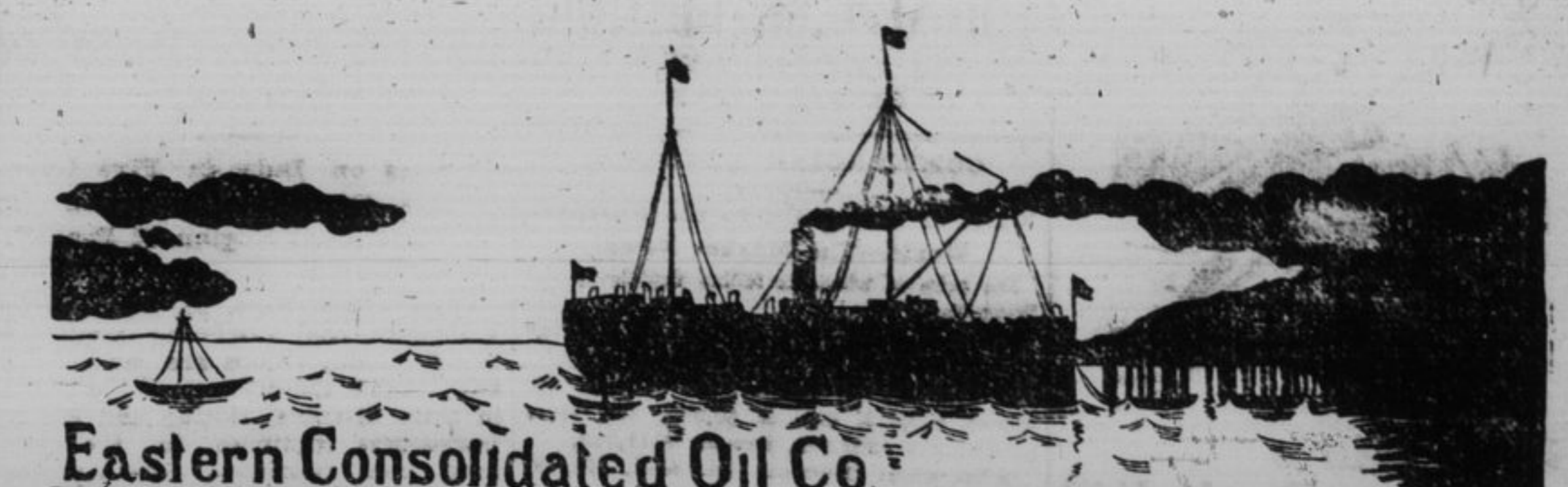

REVOLUTION IN OIL INDUSTRY. Fuel Oil on Ocean Steamers.

LEUTENANT WINCHELL, U.S.N., reports the trial trip of 6,876 miles by the oil-burning steamer Mariposa as entirely satisfactory. It practically required 1 1/2 pounds of oil an hour to secure a horse-power, which is just about 50% less in weight of combustion than would be required of coal.
