ADDINGTON TEMPERANCE PEOPLE ORGANIZE

Officers of the Association Selected - A Feeling of Complete Unity Among the Delegates - Will Work to Win the Election.

Napaneve, Ont. On Saturday last at Newburgh, the organization was effected by the temperance people of Addington for the campaign on the approaching vote on the Ontario liquor act.

At the morning session, after devotional exercises conducted by Revs. Moore of Newburgh, and Neville of Roblin, J. M. Denyes was elected chairman pro tem, and officers of the Addington Prohibition Association were elected as follows: Hon. president, Rev. J. H. Chant; president, Rev. J. E. Moore, Ph. B.; secretary, J. M. Denyes, B.A.; treasurer, Rev. J. G. Gardner.

The feeling of the delegates at the morning session was one of complete unity as to the necessity of accepting conditions as they are in regard to the referendum, not wasting time or energy in discussing the unfairness of the referendum when the conditions of the vote are now beyond possibility of remedy.

On motion it was decided by the convention to ask the publishers of the Napaneve Beaver and the Express to accord the association one column each per week from now until December 1st, for the presentation of their side of the campaign, and in case of the granting of this favor, Messrs. Charles McKay and J. M. Denyes were chosen to edit these columns.

At the afternoon session, presided over by the president, stirring addresses were delivered by Revs. Neville of Roblin, Spence of Bath, and Weatherill of Enterprise, Mr. Neville said that this fight was not one of ordinary or commonplace, but was a personal conflict in which every man's conscience was at stake.

Rev. Mr. Spence noted the already existing organizations of the anti-prohibition forces, which were of so many shades of interest that it was difficult to meet them all.

Rev. Mr. Weatherill emphasized the necessity of a clear-cut declaration of the temperance people, and the purification of ourselves from every interest allied with the liquor traffic, and education of ourselves in the merits of our cause and a unification of our forces.
