Not since the collapse of the land boom, which wrecked so many banks and other financial institutions, and reduced so many people from opulence to poverty, have times been so hard as they are now, writes a correspondent from Melbourne.

They have borrowed to such an extent that the flotation of further loans in London is anything but an easy thing to do, and in most of the states large deficits are shown on the year's transactions. Rigid retrenchments and economy, as well as further taxation, are the only means by which the states can extricate themselves from the financial straits they have got themselves into by piling up the public debt and reckless expenditure upon unproductive works.
