ONTARIO'S GOOD WORK.

Forestry Work of The Experimental Union.

Dr. B. E. Fernow, director of the New York State College of Forestry, has been secured by the Experimental Union to deliver two addresses on forestry at its annual meeting at Ontario Agricultural College, Guelph, on the 8th and 9th of December.

At the Ontario Agricultural College lectures on forestry have been given regularly to the students for twenty years.

In 1901, committees were appointed by the Experimental Union to carry on co-operative work throughout Ontario in agriculture, horticulture, forestry, economic botany, and poultry raising.

The forestry question will occupy the same place on the programme of the union meeting this year that the sugar beet question did in 1901.
